Dr. Maria Su is the Executive Director of the San Francisco Department of Children, Youth and Their Families (DCYF). She is also a commissioner on the San Francisco First 5 Children and Families Commission and is Co-Chair of the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council. Su was appointed by Mayor Gavin Newsom to lead DCYF in 2009.

DCYF allocated approximately \$90M each year for services that support children and youth from birth to age 24 and their families. Su has worked in senior management posts at a nonprofit agency in San Francisco's Tenderloin District and at UCSF. Su received

her Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from Boston University and Doctor of Psychology Degree from Alliant International University-CSPP.
