





Forecasted trajectories for grades 3-8, reading RIT scores based on COVID-19 induced school closures.









COVID-19 Learning Loss: Mathematics forecast

Our Policy Recommendations for Partners

Use federal investments and flexibilities to close the inevitable gaps – now and in the future.

- Make up lost instructional time. More time with teachers—whatever it takes.
- 2 Create very clear, strategic restart plans for schools now.
- 3 Surround kids with learning outside the classroom.
- Use the demand for distance learning as a catalyst to create more blended learning options.




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National Summer Learning Week
